Requirements:

- 1. In Mesa County and the City of Grand Junction it shall be unlawful for any dog that has been found to be a Dangerous Dog by any Court to be confined in a matter that does not included the following requirements. When outside the owner's primary residence, the dog must be:
 - confined to an escape proof kennel approved by Mesa County Animal Services; or
 - on a leash and under the direct control of a responsible adult; and
 - confined in such a matter that complies with any additional safety or confinement restrictions ordered by the Court that found the dog Dangerous unless amended by a Court in our jurisdiction.
- 2. In Mesa County and the City of Grand Junction the owner of any dog that has been found to be a Dangerous Dog by any Court and is residing in Mesa County or the City of Grand Junction must obtain an annual special permit and identification tag for such animal. The permit shall expire on December 31 of the year for which the permit is issued. An application for the special permit and identification tag shall be made to Mesa County Animal Services thirty days prior to the expiration date of the existing permit along with the Dangerous Dog Special Permit fee of \$100. The Dangerous Dog Special Permit tag shall be worn by the dog at all times.
- 3. The owner shall allow the Mesa County Animal Services Officer access to the property where the dangerous dog is be harbored for inspections and insure compliance for the duration of the life of the animal. Prior to approving the annual permit, an inspection of the escape proof kennel where the dangerous is harbored will be completed by Mesa County Animal Services. If

4.	any problems are noted with the kennel, they must be corrected before the annual permit is approved. The owner shall allow the Mesa County Animal Services Officer to photograph the dog and the confinement area and to verify the microchip. Please provide a minimum of three dates and times (approximately 30 minutes) that the officer can meet with you to complete these items. An officer will contact you to set an appointment.

	must disclose in writing to the prospective owner that the dangerous dog has been the								
	subject of a conviction of this section.								
	The dog owner shall permanently identify the dangerous dog through the implantation								
	of a microchip by a licensed veterinarian or shelter.
